The Pinot Noir - also called Blauer Burgunder in our latitudes - is a red wine that likes it a little cooler. That's why it fits very well into our vineyards in the cool northern Kamptal. The Pinot Noir grows on a clay soil mixed with mica slate, which extends to the surface of the earth, at about 350m above sea level. After hand-picking and spontaneous fermentation, the Pinot Noir was poured into used oak barrels to age on the fine lees for a year. The Pinot Noir 18 is very typical of the variety, ie very light color, subtle scent of red berries, soft tannin, very delicate. It is not a heavy, dense red wine, but shines with its lightness and elegance.
